



Corporate Membership — Dues & Fees (2026)

Corporate Membership is for a corporation that will include a registered sole proprietorship, registered partnership, Limited Partnership, incorporated company or professional company. Corporate Membership may allow up to 3 designated officers or employees to enjoy the social privileges of the Club. Corporate Members are subject to the following dues and charges.

INITIATION FEE

First designate	\$1,250.00
Second designate	\$1062.00
Third designate	&875.00

All fees and dues are subject to HST

ANNUALLY FEES - DUES

One designate	\$2,346.00
Two designates	\$3,830.00
Three designates	\$5,314.00

All fees and dues are subject to HST

CAPITAL FUND

One designate	\$636.00
Two designates	\$1,272.00
Three designates	\$1,908.00

All fees and dues are subject to HST

MINIMUM FOOD & BEVERAGE CHARGES

Corporate Memberships carry an annual minimum spending requirement of:

One designate per year	\$900.00
Two designates per year	\$1800.00
Three designates per year	\$2700.00

(not including taxes or gratuity)

Minimums apply to all food and beverage purchases charged to the corporate membership number. The minimum spending period of one year begins on the first day of the month of the 1st designate's birthday. Credit card transactions cannot be traced to the membership number, so only charges billed to the account count toward minimums, consistent with the Active Member policy: "only purchases charged to your account number are applied to your minimums". Corporate Members are responsible for paying any unused minimums. Purchases at reciprocal clubs and in the Boatique do **not** apply toward minimums.

NEW CORPORATE MEMBER BILLING

Upon receipt of a completed Corporate Membership application, new corporate membership number will be assigned, which will be referenced in a statement at the end of that month to acknowledge receipt of the initiation fee. Applications are posted for 30 days in the front lobby and will go to the Board of Directors for approval, subject to Board Regulations, at the next Board of Directors' meeting. Board meetings are generally held on the third or fourth Monday of every month. Monthly dues will be charged starting in the first month after approval. During the posting period, and prior to approval, new designated corporate members may use the Club but must pay for services by credit or debit cards, as their membership number will not be effective until approved by the Board.

GRATUITIES

Charges for all food and beverage consumed within the Club are subject to an automatic 17 per cent gratuity charge. Takeout meals are subject to an automatic 10 per cent gratuity charge. Catered corporate events may be subject to a service charge. The gratuity will also be added to the bills of corporate members' guests who pay their own charges.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Statements ending on the last day of the previous month are mailed or emailed out to members during the first week of the following month. The statements include the dues for the upcoming month, the capital assessment fund charge, if applicable, and any charges incurred during the month. Corporate accounts must remain in good standing. The corporation is responsible for all charges made by its designated officers.

BOAT WELLS

Boat wells are not available to Corporate Membership.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

All Corporate Members and designated users are subject to the Club's Bylaws and Board Regulations as published on the Windsor Yacht Club website.
