## HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER



1. Determine what type of membership you are applying for:
  - a. Intermediate Member - are members from the ages of 19 to 35 inclusively. Intermediate members shall be entitled to the entire privileges of the Club. These members shall be able to attend all membership meetings of the Club, are entitled to vote and are able to hold office. Upon reaching the age of 36, an intermediate member will become an active member and will commence paying dues for the active class.
  - b. Active Member - are members who are entitled to the entire privileges of the Club. These members shall be able to attend all membership meetings of the Club, are entitled to vote and are able to hold office.
  - c. Out of Town Social Member - are members who have made application under Bylaw 2.01 to the Board of Directors to obtain such class of membership and in the opinion of the Board either do not maintain a residence within a 75-kilometre radius of the Club or they maintain their sole residence outside of Canada. Out of Town Members shall have full social privileges of the Club. They will have the right to attend meetings but shall not be able to vote or hold office.
  - d. Corporate Membership – entitle up to three members of a corporation to enjoy the entire privileges of the club. One of these three members, designated by the corporation, shall be able to attend all membership meetings of the club and are entitled to vote and are able to hold office. Special initiation rates are available for corporations.
2. Complete an application form (found online or by picking up a package at the club).

3. Have your sponsor sign your application. If you need a sponsor, drop by the WYC for assistance.
4. Submit your application to the office.
5. Meet four Board of Directors' and obtain signatures with the assistance of your sponsor, or WYC Director of Operations, or the Membership Director. This is easily done on a Friday or Saturday evening.
6. Your application will be posted for thirty days in the main lobby for membership to review. While posted, all WYC facilities may be enjoyed, but charges must be paid by credit card or debit.
7. The Board of Directors will consider your membership, after the posting time has elapsed, at the next monthly Board meeting.
8. Once approved, the Membership Director or Director of Operations will advise so that you can then charge all WYC related purchases to your account. A membership number will be assigned to you from the office.
9. Activities, events, some club merchandise, food and beverages can be charged to your membership number once approved.
10. New members will be invited to a membership orientation evening.
