



Notice of Race (Amendment 1; Sept 16 2020)

1) RULES

- 1.1 The 45th Annual Chimo Race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* for 2017-2020 (RRS). These include sailing instructions provided by the Windsor Yacht Club (WYC).
- 1.2 RRS 62.1 "Redress" and RRS A2 "Series Scores" may be changed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The U.S. Sailing prescriptions to the RRS shall apply.
- 1.4 The Organizing Authority for this regatta series is the Windsor Yacht Club (WYC).

2) ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The 45th Annual Chimo Race is open to all boats owned by clubs, or member of clubs, holding current memberships in the Detroit River Yachting Association (DRYA) and to others on invitation of the WYC. All PHRF handicaps will be those as assigned by the DRYA, non-member DRYA boats may apply for a PJAM rating at 23915 Jefferson Ave, St. Clair Shores, MI 48080, (586) 778-1000 or email thedrya@drya.org. Boats racing without a DRYA or assigned rating will not be scored.
- 2.2 All boat previously entered in the 2020 WYC Wednesday Night Race Series are automatically entered into the 45th Annual Chimo Race and no further application or fees apply.
- 2.3 All other competitors may enter by completing the attached form and sending it by September 26th, 2020 to:

- 2.4 There are no fees to participate, but registration is required.

3) SCHEDULE

- 3.1 The 45th Annual Chimo Race will be held on September 27th, 2020.
- 3.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the start of the first class is 13:55 for a River start of 14:10 for a Lake start.

4) MEASUREMENT

4.1 Each boat shall provide a valid rating certificate during registration **or** at minimum of 48-hours prior to the boat's first race be listed on either the most current DRYA valid **or** PJAM rating list(s).

5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be made available online after May 1, 2020 through the WYC website www.windsoryachtclub.com by clicking on Race tab.

6) VENUE/COURSES

6.1 The location of the courses for the 45th Annual Chimo Race will be designated in the Sailing Instructions provided by the WYC.

7) PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1 Penalties for breaking rules in Part 2 of the RRS will be provided in RRS 44.1.

8) SCORING SYSTEM

8.1 Boats in all classes will be scored according to their corrected times, calculated on a time-on-time basis.

8.2 The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply except as modified below.

8.3 The 45th Annual Chimo Race will be scored as a long series: DNF, DNS, OCS, RAF, DSQ, etc with points equal to the number of boats racing in that class/fleet, plus one. A boat that did not come to the starting area will not receive any points.

8.4 Boats will be scored and listed after each race on the WYC website www.windsoryachtclub.com.

9) SUPPORT BOATS

9.1 Support boats shall display a flag marked "RC".

10) RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 Radio communication shall be via VHF Radio CH72.

11) COURTESY BROADCASTS

11.1 An unofficial designated observer may report all visual signals displayed by the Race Committee over the VHF CH72. Information so reported is provided as a courtesy to competitors and does not alter the competitors' responsibility to

observe the Race Committee's visual signals, which govern the conduct of the racing. Errors or omissions by the observer, or a competitor's failure to hear an observer's report will not be grounds for redress.

11.2 All boats are urged to designate a crew member to monitor VHF CH72 at all times during the event.

12) DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the WYC 45th Annual Chimo Race at their own risk. See RRS4, "Decision to Race". The WYC or the WYC Race Committee will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the 45th Annual Chimo Race.

13) INSURANCE

13.1 The owner of each participating yacht is responsible to maintain liability insurance on his or her vessel. A minimum of \$300,000.00 liability coverage is recommended. A valid Certificate of Insurance is to be provided at the time of registration.

14) CHANGING SAIL CONFIGURATION

14.1 Boats that have raced in the 2020 WYC Wednesday Night Race Series shall race with the same sail configuration. To change configuration prior to the 45th Annual Chimo Race boats must follow the same process shall be used as changing class designation.
