



WYC *Canadian Club*® Overnight Race
SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF RACE (SNOR)



All competing boats are strongly recommended to sail under auxiliary power, past the Windsor Yacht Club heading upstream and stop momentarily to report their sail number and receive a Memento from our sponsor. Mementos will be available for the first 80 boats sailing past WYC starting at 17:30 hr before the first warning signal at 18:55 hr on Friday, June 12, 2026.

WYC

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 WYC Canadian Club Racer – a DRYA member boat that has registered to race in DRYA Counter Series Regattas.
- 1.2 Invited Boat - boats other than DRYA registered boats on invitation of WYC or DRYA registered boats racing outside their designated class.
- 1.3 WYC is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the regatta.
- 1.4 Club Supplemental Notice of Race (SNORs) and Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SSIs) – race documents issued by WYC which, in addition to the DRYA NOR and DRYA SI, govern the conduct of an individual Sponsoring Club's regatta.
- 1.5 Penalty Definitions: [DP] and [NP] as follows:
[DP] – Discretionary Penalty, for administrative or logistical rules like submission deadlines where at the discretion of the Protest Committee may/will be less than disqualification. (See RRS 64 and M5)
[NP] – Non-protestable Penalty, for rules where redress is not permitted, like PRO Wind readings. This changes RRS 60.1 and 61.1(a).

2. RULES

- 2.4 WYC's Supplemental (SNORs) and Sailing Instructions (SSIs) shall govern in case of conflicts with the 2026 DRYA NOR and SI.
- 2.5 All W/L details in DRYA documents are hereby deleted. Other details may be modified in these supplemental instructions

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The WYC Canadian Club Race is open to boats owned by DRYA member clubs or members of DRYA clubs holding current memberships in the DRYA.
- 3.3 Invited boats shall also register and pay any fees for entry on the DRYA/WYC website by Tuesday prior to the regatta day. WYC will supply DRYA with the info to generate scratch sheets.

4. FEES

- 4.2 Invited Host Club member boats racing in the Club Jam regatta – No charge. If racing in a DRYA Class - \$50/Regatta. Invited non Host Club boats racing in JAM or DRYA Classes - \$50.00 per regatta.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
- 6.1 The DRYA Sailing Instruction (2026 DRYA SI) shall be posted to [DRYA.org](https://www.drya.org) no later than April 15, 2026.
- 6.2 WYC's Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SSI's) for their regatta shall be posted to [DRYA.org](https://www.drya.org) no later than three weeks prior to their regatta.

7. VENUE
All racing shall take place on Lake St. Clair.

8. COURSES, CLASSES and CLASS SPLITS
Classes and Class Splits shall be as described in the 2026 DRYA SI.

10. AUDIO COMMUNICATIONS
- 10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make or receive voice or data transmissions that are not available to all boats.
- 10.2 Radio communication on all regatta courses shall be on VHF Channel 72.

11. AWARDS
- 11.1 Awards will be presented at the WYC Awards Banquet on October 17, 2026. Event details will be available online at www.windsoryachtclub.com by September 1, 2026. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each class
